

## Charitable Donations Statement

The Sacramento Veterans Resource Group (Sac VERG) is chartered to operate as a California Non-Profit corporation with a 501(c)3 tax status. Presently in pending status, Sac VERG operates with a 501(c)3 fiduciary sponsor, Vouch4Vets.Org. This contract allows Sac VERG to collect sponsor contributions and provide tax deductible documentation.

All Sac VERG operations and expenses are supported by volunteers and paid for solely by sponsor contributions and fundraising events. There are no paid employees. This allows the organization to offer membership, services, and various activities at no cost.

As a start-up organization we have relied upon our initial donors to manage the many costs associated with chartering a California non-profit corporation, but to accomplish our mission we need support from our member companies.

The sponsorship support will be to fund the board approved annual operating budget. A portion of the annual budget covers expenses associated with internal operations (i.e. banking, insurance, marketing, technology, office expenses, etc.). Within the approved budget, the majority of the donated funds will be used to cover expenses associated with supporting the organization's mission, including but not limited to;

- Hosting recurring Educational and Networking Events where members can learn and share tools, resources, and information to help them recruit, hire, retain and support veteran employees
- Develop and maintain an ever-growing *virtual toolbox* of valuable resources and best practices to help employers create and maintain successful internal veteran programs.
- Hosting and promoting Veteran Resource Fairs where veterans and their families can access employment, community services and other groups in support of their success the Sacramento region.
- Sponsoring recurring Community Service Projects that leverage broad local support for important causes to aid our veteran community.
- Hosting Community Engagement Events where employers, veterans and families can meet and come together in a fun setting to experience the camaraderie that is typically associated with those that have a military background.
